

Edward trained at the Poor School between 1989-91.

He has worked mainly in theatre, including several international tours with the English Shakespeare Company of Twelfth Night (dir. Michael Pennington), Macbeth and The Tempest (dir. Michael Bogdanov) and Julius Caesar (dir. Tim Carroll); together with work at Stephen Joseph (dir. Alan Ayckbourn), the Dukes Lancaster, Oldham Coliseum and Birmingham Rep (dir. Tony Clark).

He also co-produced and acted in Cold Words and Whisky Breath (London Fringe) and Ghosts, (Scottish tour, dir. John Doyle.)

Most recent work includes A Christmas Carol - his own one-man version, together with voice and music (Helena Leonard and Carl Penlington-Williams) and Mr. Darcy in the Audio Drama, Pride & Prejudice which is available to listen to exclusively at Dramafy.com.







Born in Cheshire, Helena Leonard studied at Trinity College of Music in London; gaining a LTCL she then completed a Postgraduate Vocal Diploma at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama before going on to advanced studies at the National Opera Studio. Her professional debut came with ENO, with roles and covers including First Lady in Die Zauberflöte; Second Niece in Peter Grimes and Helena in A Midsummer Night's Dream. This led to further appearances as Musetta in La Boheme for Scottish Opera and Marcellina in Le Nozze Di Figaro for Grange Park Opera; Donna Anna in Don Giovanni and Giulietta in Les Contes d' Hoffmann for Opera Box.

Helena has also sung the role of Tosca for Opera Project and Scottish Opera (understudy); the title role in Aida for Opera Box and Welsh National Opera (understudy) and Lady Maebeth in Verdi's Maebeth for Scottish Opera Go Round. She has also performed in a gala Opera concert at The Cadogan Hall with The Hillingdon Choral Society & Orchestra, the role of Leonora in Il Trovatore (understudy) for Welsh National Opera and the title role in Ariadne auf Naxos (understudy) also for WNO.

Helena is Co-Artistic Director of Little Pixie Productions and has performed in and co devised three of our shows: The Nightingale of South Bank, Sing We Noel and Operatastic! The Accessible Guide to Opera. She has also appeared in our Christmas show Paper Angel, A Christmas Carol and in our national tour of The Snow Queen.

Helena's television work has included the Countess in La nozze di Figaro in Nicholas Nickleby for Carlton Television.


